Sunday School:

If we look at the blessing in our lives, which do we notice first? The material things? Or the favor, honor, and special status that God shows us as his children?

Do we ask God every day to enlarge our territory; to help us reach more people?

According to Eph 1: there are six spiritual blessings:

- 1. He chose us.
- 2. Redemption by his blood.
- 3. Forgiveness of our sins
- 4. Wisdom and understanding with him.
- 5. He will let known to us the mystery of his will when we need to know.
- 6. Believing you are marked by him.

Are we afraid to ask for these gifts? Do we think of all the reasons we aren't worthy? Do we come up with excuses as to why we can't have these basic gifts from God?

We need to pray in a way that we ask God for these things every day. We need to remember that God's time is different, and we are to live by faith. An unconditional blessing, is God's gift to us every day, something we don't have to ask for, his love. So take a little time every day, and ask God to bless you, to make you more honorable, to make you uncomfortable, so that you may honor him.

Message:

Are you using religion as an excuse? Check out this YouTube video by Jefferson Betuke, "Why I Hate Religion." Many of the questions, and thoughts that he discusses have probably gone though your head as well.

Do you ask God what he really wants from you? We need to be thankful, not fearful, of what God has planned for us.
